Getting Better Drying Results From Your Dishwasher

- Use Rinse Aid — most dispensers hold about 1/2 bottle.
- Select Dry Boost (Normal or High).
The 1-Hour cycle does not automatically dry unless Dry Boost is selected.
- Plastics may remain wet after a cycle and some moisture on the door and walls is normal.
- For better cleaning:
Liquid detergent and gel pods/packs are recommended over powder. They generally clean better and leave less residue.

Snow Preparations

It's time to prepare!

- Snow Keys: If you have a snow key on file, please pick it up at the Office and test your key fob battery. Replace the battery if needed, then return all snow keys by September 30.
- Snow Placards: Need a replacement placard for your car? Please let the Office know by the end of September.
- Parking: When snow is expected, please remind guests and visitors to park only in designated areas.
- Snow parking maps are available at the Office.

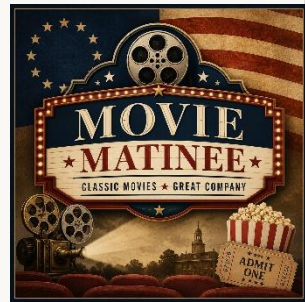

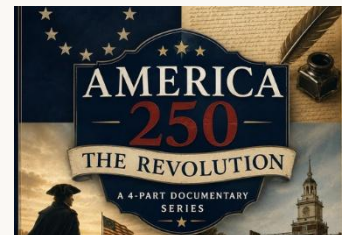
